



ROUTE 31 | CRANSTON STREET

Route 31 operates between the Brewery Parkade in Cranston and Kennedy Plaza in downtown Providence. It provides direct, straightforward service through a high-density residential corridor, and is anchored at its outer end by a strong shopping destination, the Brewery Parkade. Increasing frequency on Route 31 would relieve overcrowding on some trips.

Proposed Changes

- Increase frequency to every 15 minutes during the day, and 30 minutes during the evening.
- Designate Route 31 as a Key Corridor route, making it eligible for enhanced passenger amenities and other Rapid Bus type upgrades in the future.
- Uncouple from Route 56 Chalkstone in order to provide more frequent service on Route 31.

Related Changes

- Route 18 Union Avenue will also provide service on the inner portion of Cranston Street at a 30 minute frequency during peak hours, 45 minutes during the midday, and 60 minutes during the evening.
