



ROUTE 34 | EAST PROVIDENCE

Route 34 operates between the Citizens Bank Operations Center, off of Tripps Lane in East Providence, and Kennedy Plaza via Evergreen Apartments, Wampanoag Plaza, Pawtucket Avenue, Warren Avenue and I-195. It is a circuitous route, serving activity centers in many parts of East Providence.

Proposed Changes

- Re-align service so that it would be faster and more direct: begin service at the Evergreen Apartments and follow the existing alignment to Wampanoag Plaza, then follow a more direct route to downtown Providence via Taunton Avenue, Six Corners, and Interstate 95/Washington Bridge.
- Discontinue service on Tripps Lane between Evergreen Apartments and Citizen’s Bank. Service would continue to be available to the Citizen’s Bank Operations Center on a re-aligned Route 32, maintaining service to this employment site every 60 minutes plus an additional inbound departure to coincide with the end of the last evening work shift.
- Replace service on Warren Avenue with Route 32, which would operate every 60 minutes.
- Operate with regular, consistent frequencies: every 60 minutes from 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM.

Related Changes

- Route 32 West Barrington would change its route (and potentially be renamed 32 East Providence/Wampanoag) to operate between Citizen’s Bank on Tripps Lane and Kennedy Plaza. It would travel via Wampanoag Trail, Pawtucket Avenue, Martin Street, Broadway and Warren Avenue to the Washington Bridge into Providence. Route 32 would operate every 60 minutes, and replace would Route 34 service on Warren Avenue (east of Broadway) and to the Citizen’s Bank on Tripps Lane.
