



ROUTE 73 | FAIRLAWN / CCRI

Route 73 Fairlawn/CCRI operates between CCRI Lincoln and the Pawtucket Transit Center via Twin River Casino, Louisquisset Pike, Charles Street, and Mineral Spring Avenue. Route 73 duplicates service provided by Routes 51 Charles Street and 54 Lincoln / Woonsocket.

Proposed Changes

Route 73 would be combined with Route 58 Mineral Spring/North Providence and reconfigured to operate between Georgiaville Manor and the Pawtucket Transit Center (rather than Kennedy Plaza) via Smithfield Commons. This change would improve crosstown service to Pawtucket, and reduce duplication along Charles Street.

- Operate reconfigured route between Georgiaville Manor in Smithfield and the Pawtucket Transit Center via Smithfield Commons, Putnam Pike, Mineral Spring Avenue.
- Replace Route 73’s Louisquisset Pike segment to CCRI with reconfigured Route 51 Charles Street service, which would operate between Kennedy Plaza and CCRI-Lincoln via Charles Street and Louisquisset Pike.
- Operate service with consistent headways:
 - On weekdays from approximately 6:30 AM to 6:30 PM, ever 60 minutes throughout the day.
 - On Saturdays from approximately 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM, every 120 minutes throughout the day.
 - On Sundays from approximately 9:00 AM to 5:30 PM, every 120 minutes throughout the day.
- Operate service as Route 73 Mineral Spring/North Providence.
