



ROUTE 75 | DEXTER

Route 75 provides infrequent service between the Lincoln Mall and the Pawtucket Transit Center via Route 122/Mendon Road, Route 116/George Washington Highway, and Central Falls.

Route 75 would be extended to Bryant University via George Washington Highway, to improve service between Pawtucket and Bryant College. To enable the provision of consistent service, the very low ridership variant service to North Central Industrial Park would be discontinued. Service levels would also be adjusted to better match service with demand, and Sunday service would be discontinued due to very low ridership.

Proposed Changes

- Extend service from Lincoln Mall to Bryant University.
- Shorten span of service on weekdays and Saturdays due to low ridership on first and last trips.
- Discontinue Sunday service due to very low ridership.
- Improve weekday service frequencies to every 45 minutes to provide a basic level of convenience.
- Increase Saturday service frequencies to every 45 minutes to provide a basic level of convenience.
- Discontinue service to the North Central Industrial Park due to low ridership, and to enable the provision of consistent service.
